Tree Type	Characteristics	Needle Retention	Branch Strength	Sizes Available	Cost
Noble Fir 	Classic triangle shape and layered look, classic fir tree smell, usually blue/green	5 / 5	5 / 5	4' - 10'	\$\$\$\$
Nordman Fir 	Dense and symmetrical layered look, low fragrance level, shiny deep green look	4 / 5	5 / 5	6' - 8'	\$\$\$
Fraser Fir 	Attractive triangular shape, fragrant woody scent, slimmer branches, forest green color with silver undersides	5 / 5	5 / 5	5' - 8'	\$\$\$

Tree Type	Characteristics	Needle Retention	Branch Strength	Sizes Available	Cost
Grand Fir 	Usually has a lower and greater girth, citrus aroma, long green needles with silver underside	3 / 5	4 / 5	5' - 8'	\$\$\$
Douglas Fir 	Usually trimmed to a near perfect cone, dark forest green color	3 / 5	4 / 5	3' - 8'	\$\$
Interior Douglas Fir 	Layered open natural look, thin lighter green needles, also known as the Charlie Brown	3 / 5	3 / 5	1' - 11'	\$
